MR. FITZPATRICK DISRUPTED THE LAWFUL PROCEEDINGS OF THE MONROE COUNTY GRAN JURY . THE JURORS WAS LISTING TO TESTIMONY ON A CASE BEING PRESENTED TO THE PANEL BY DEPUTY PAT WILSON WHEN THE DEFENDANT BURST THE THE DOOR WITH AT LEAST SEVEN OTHER PERSONS STANDING OUTSIDE WITH CAMCORDERS SHOUTING TO ARREST THE GRAN JURY FORMAN GARY PETWAY. THE DEFENDANT CONTUIED TO RAISE HIS VOICE WHICH PREVENTED DEPUTY WILSONS TESTIMONY THIS OFFICER WAS REQUIRED TO RESPOND AN ORDERED TO REMOVE MR. FITZPATRICK. ONLY WHEN THE HE WAS ESCORTED OUT WAS THE GRAN JURY ABLE TO CONTINUE WITH THEIR PROCEEDINGS. FURTHER, THE DEFENDANT WAS CAUSING PUBLIC ANNOYANCE AND REFUSED TO OBEY AN OFFICAL ORDER CAUSING UNREASONABLE NOISE WHICH PREVENTED OTHERS FROM CARRYING OUT OFFICIAL LAWFUL ACTIVITIES . THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT CAUSED ALARM AND SERVED NO LEGITIMATE PUPOSE .
